

# **APPLICATION MATERIALS**

- Scanned copy of notarized highest diploma. Chinese/English translation is required for texts other than Chinese and English. Prospective diploma recipients must submit official documents issued by current school to prove current student status or expected graduation date.
- 2. Scanned copies of notarized transcripts. Chinese/English translation is required for texts other than Chinese and English; prospective graduates can provide current transcripts when applying
- 3. Scanned copy of passport homepage
- 4. Certificate of no criminal record
- 5. Scanned copy of valid Foreigner Physical Examination Form
- 6. If you are studying in China, an attendance letter issued by current host university in China with contact information is required.

#### **HOW TO APPLY**

- 1. Apply at https://lut.at0086.cn/StuApplication/Login.aspx.
- 2. Pay the application fee at as instructed in the email. https://pay.lut.edu.cn/xysf/ptman/login.aspx
- 3. You will receive an electronic version of the Confirmation Form for Study in China (JW202) or Information Form for Foreign Students' Short-term Visit (DQ) and the admission notice.
- 4. You need to apply for a student visa (X visa) at the local embassy with the admission notice and the electronic JW202/DQ.
- 5. Register at Lanzhou University of Technology.

### **INSURANCE**

In accordance with the regulations of the Ministry of Education of the People's Republic of China, All students are required to purchase insurance. The insurance premium is CNY 400/year, CNY 400/semester, CNY 100/month.



### <u>VISA</u>

Students participating in Chinese language programs must hold a  $\rm X1/X2$  visa. Other types of visa are not acceptable.

#### **COURSES**

LUT offers elementary, intermediate and advanced courses. The courses mainly consist of Comprehensive Chinese, Chinese Listening and Speaking, Chinese Reading and Writing, Chinese Culture and HSK tutoring, with 26 to 28 weekly class hours.

#### Short-term Group Chinese Language Program

Application for short-term language program is accepted year-round.



- 1. A minimum of 15 students to form a class;
- 2. Students should have a roughly equivalent Chinese language proficiency level;
- 3. Students must be aged 14 or above.

The study duration, curriculum, itinerary arrangements, and fees can be determined through negotiation.



LUT offers International Chinese Language Teachers Scholarship for one-year study program students, one-semester study program students and four-week study program students.

Scholarship coverage: tuition,accommodation,comprehensive medical insurance, living allowance(excluding four-week study program students). The monthly allowance for undergraduates, one-year study program students and one-semester study program students is CNY 2,500 per month.
